WHAT: The 5th Latin American Conference on Lung Cancer, hosted by the International Association for the Study of Lung Cancer, will highlight the latest research in the early detection, prevention and treatment of lung cancer, the leading cause of death not only in Latin America but worldwide.

WHEN: July 25-27, 2012

WHERE: Windsor Barra Hotel, Rio de Janeiro, Brazil

WHO: Founded in 1972, IASLC's membership includes more than 3,500 lung cancer specialists in 80 countries. Membership is open to any physician, health professional or scientist interested in lung cancer.

FAST FACTS:

- About 1,000 delegates are expected to attend the conference in Rio de Janeiro, the *Cidade Maravilhosa* or "Marvelous City" and host of the 2014 final match of the FIFA Soccer World Cup and the 2016 Summer Olympics.
- Attendees include surgeons, medical oncologists, radiation oncologists, pulmonologists, radiologists, pathologists, epidemiologists, basic research scientists, nurses and allied health professionals.
- Groundbreaking cancer research will be presented in two full days of plenary sessions, general sessions, industry symposia, poster and abstract sessions.
